How do I apply?

PROCEDURE:

1. Find a supervisor.
2. Fill out the form on the site **enter.unn.ru** and send it.
3. Wait for your receipt notice, download the electronic version of your application.
4. Send scanned copies of the following documents to **info@priem-phd.unn.ru** in a separate archived folder:
 - a signed application form;
 - a signed Consent to The Collecting and Processing of Personal Data;
 - a copy of your passport;
 - a copy of your valid visa;
 - a notarized translation of your passport;
 - a copy of your diploma;
 - a notarized translation of your diploma (if you studied outside Russia);
 - your photo.

Documents can also be submitted in person.

5. Pass the entrance exams. Foreign citizens entering within the framework of the quota for the education of foreign citizens are enrolled without entrance exams.

Upon admission, you must provide:

- the original of the notarized translation of your passport;
- the original of the notarized translation of your diploma (if you studied outside Russia);
- the certificate of the Recognition of foreign higher education and (or) qualifications (if you studied outside Russia);

For recognition of your foreign higher education and (or) qualifications you may contact The Center of Recognition of foreign higher education and (or) qualifications of UNN



- a medical certificate and a copy of your health insurance document.

Entrance exams

1. If you apply for PhD degrees in UNN you must pass the following entrance exams:
 - special discipline corresponding to the field of your study and research (hereinafter referred to as the special discipline)
 - foreign language (English, German or French).
2. All entrance exams are conducted in Russian. In case you apply for a program taught in English, entrance exams are conducted in English.
3. If you failed to pass a certain exam you will not be allowed to retake it.
4. The entrance examination for a special discipline consists of two parts:
 - exam in a special discipline (assessed on a 10-point scale);
 - an interview on the subject of the future dissertation research based on an abstract prepared by the applicant (assessed on a 10-point scale).
